## Summer Reading Challenge 2009

Open a book and find out how creative you can be!

Keep up with the time you spend reading this summer. Every time you read 20 minutes, mark a box on the game board. Follow the trail of creative characters all summer long!

### Instructions

Begin with the first block next to the picture of the marching band. When you have read 20 minutes, color in that first block. For each 20 minutes you read, color the next block on the game board. If an adult, brother, sister, or friend reads to you, that time counts, too!



Keep up with your game board all summer, and keep marking those boxes. Your goal is to read 2000 minutes this summer!

Early in the new school year, the Washington PTA will reward all students who have read at least **500** minutes with fun prizes you can take home, and drawings for fun things to do at school! The PTA challenges you to read as much as you can, to earn special surprises, because you earn another reward when you read 1000, 1500, and 2000 minutes!

Keep your game board in a safe place over the summer. Your teacher will collect it soon after school starts back. Your rewards will be delivered to you in your class as soon as the PTA can collect the game boards and add up your minutes!
